I'm waiting for the employer to respond, do I need a firm job offer to apply even though I have interviewed and have a good chance of getting it?

Yes. Intern Scholarship Program awards funds based on specific job opportunities and not potential internships.

The company I want to work for doesn't have their internships posted yet? What should I do?

Send them the link to the Intern Scholarship Program website

(<https://careers.tcu.edu/students/internscholarship/>) and tell them you are hoping to apply for a scholarship. Ask them if they would consider talking with you on an expedited timeframe.

Can I work for a company or event that is being organized by my professor or academic department?

No. Eligible internships must be external to TCU.

I am starting grad school at TCU in the fall. Can I apply for an internship?

No. You must have completed at least one semester in your program and returning in the fall semester.

Can I apply for more than the minimum amount if I can provide a budget showing I need more money?

No. There are set maximum award amounts depending upon term and available funding.

My internship is out of the country. Is that okay?

Yes. We encourage students to engage in international internships.

My internship will last more than one semester. Can I apply for an award to cover both semesters?

No. You need to apply separately for each semester.
