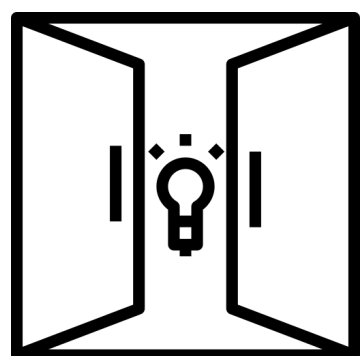

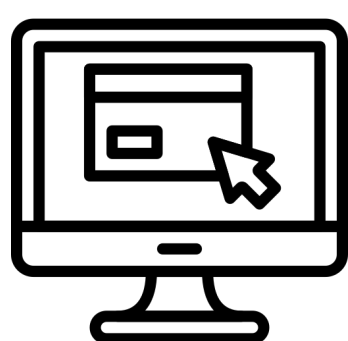

1 FIND NEW OPPORTUNITIES

Reach out to companies that are actively hiring. When searching for jobs in Handshake or LinkedIn, make sure to sort jobs by "Date Posted" to see the latest job postings.



2 EXPAND YOUR SEARCH

Search for jobs in an industry that is less impacted by the pandemic. Consider alternatives like short term work opportunities or remote/virtual projects.



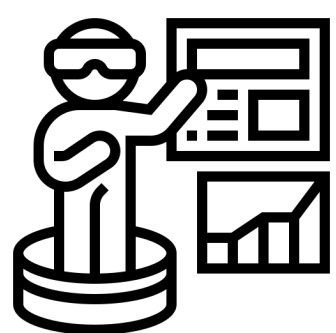
3 REVAMP YOUR RESUME

Update your resume and include your most relevant skills and experiences. Add data and metrics to quantify your achievements. Highlight your experience/ability to work remotely.



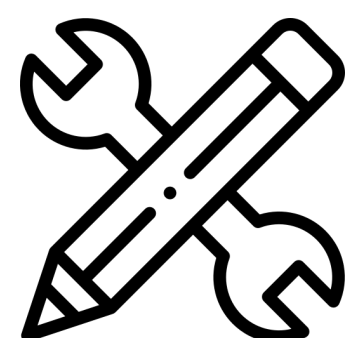
4 ATTEND VIRTUAL EVENTS

Attend free and virtual events to connect with employers. Check the Events page on Handshake regularly to explore events and register.



5 DO A VIRTUAL INTERNSHIP

Consider inquiring with your employer to see if working remotely is available. Also, check out InsideSherpa - a platform that offers free virtual internships so that you can add new experiences on your resume upon completion.



6 LEARN NEW SKILLS

Take a digital course to learn the new skill you've been putting off such as Tableau, SAP, SPSS, PowerBI. Walk away with a certification when you're done with your learning.
